## DEED OF VARIATION TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT FOR SET IXWORTH SCHOOL

THIS DEED is made the 30 day of July 2020

### BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "**Secretary of State**"); and
- 2) Seckford Education Trust (the "**Company**") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 08077362, together, the "**Parties**".

### INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a supplemental funding agreement dated 27 February 2014 as amended by deed of variation dated on or around 19 December 2018 (the "**Supplemental Funding Agreement**") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of SET Ixworth School, an Academy in accordance with the Supplemental Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Supplemental Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Supplemental Funding Agreement.

### 1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Supplemental Funding Agreement.

### 2. VARIATION OF THE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from 1 September 2020 the Supplemental Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows:

- (a) replace existing clause 2.5 with the following new clause 2.5:

"2.5 The planned capacity of the Academy is 618 in the age range 11 to 16 which, for the avoidance of doubt, includes pupils with designated places pursuant to clause 2.6. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school."

- (b) add two new clauses 2.6 and 2.7 immediately following new clause 2.5 in the following form:

"2.6 The Academy Trust must operate designated places reserved for pupils with SEN (SEN Unit or Resourced Provision) with up to 18 planned places for pupils with Communication & Interaction difficulties in the age range 11 to 16.
