(1) The Secretary of State for Education ("the Secretary of State"),

- and -

(2) **The Sandon Trust** a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number **8922806** ("the Academy").

together referred to as the "Parties"

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 30 April 2014 ("the Funding Agreement") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of an independent school known as **Sandon Primary School**.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

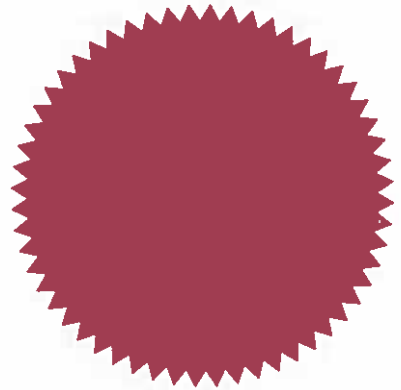
LEGAL AGREEMENT

- 3. As varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

Schedule 1

Amendments to the Funding Agreement

1. **Clause 1.2 of the Funding Agreement shall be replaced with:**

The following words and expressions shall have the following meanings:

“the Academy” means the Sandon Primary Academy to be established at Normacot Grange Road, Meir, Stoke on Trent, ST3 7AW.

“the Land” means the publicly funded land (including for the avoidance of doubt all buildings, structures landscaping and other erections) situated at and known as Sandon Primary Academy, formerly known as Grange Primary School, Normacot Road, Meir, Stoke-on-Trent, ST3 7AW and registered under title number SF552038.

“Chief Inspector” means Her Majesty’s Chief Inspector of Education, Children’s Services and Skills or his successor;

2. **All references to ‘Sandon Primary School’ within the Funding Agreement shall be replaced with references to ‘Sandon Primary Academy’, which is the name by which the Academy shall now be known.**
