**DEED OF VARIATION**  
relating to a Funding Agreement  
dated 29.03.16

THIS DEED OF VARIATION is made on 1 SEPTEMBER 2019

**BETWEEN:**

- (1) The Secretary of State for Education (“Secretary of State”); and
  - (2) Chiltern Way Academy Trust, a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 10004115 (“Company”)
- together referred to as the “Parties”.

**INTRODUCTION:**

- (A) The Parties entered into a funding agreement dated 29.03.16 (“Funding Agreement”) relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of a school known as Chiltern Way Academy.
- (B) The Parties now wish to vary and amend the terms of the Funding Agreement and wish to record their agreement as to such variations/amendments to the Funding Agreement by this Deed.

**IT IS AGREED as follows:**

1. The Secretary of State and the Company agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended and restated in the form set out at Schedule 1 to this Deed.
2. As varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This Agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with English law.

This document has been executed and delivered as a Deed on the date stated at the beginning of this Deed.

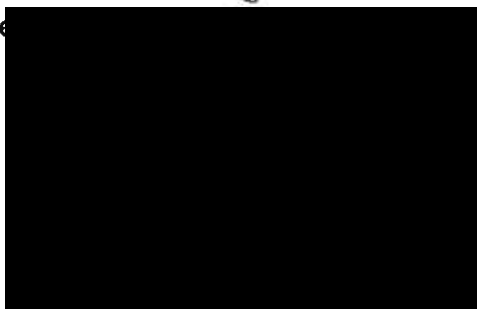
