DEED OF VARIATION TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING AGREEMENT

THIS DEED is made the 25th day of August 2020

BETWEEN

- 1) The Secretary of State for Education (the "**Secretary of State**") and
 - 2) Ponteland Academy Trust (the "**Company**") a charitable company incorporated in England and Wales with registered number 10314306,
- together the "**Parties**".

INTRODUCTION

- A. The Parties entered into a supplemental funding agreement dated 30 August 2017 (the "**Funding Agreement**") relating to the establishment, maintenance and funding of Ponteland Community Middle School in accordance with the Funding Agreement.
- B. The Parties now wish to vary and amend certain terms and conditions of the Funding Agreement in accordance with the terms of this Deed.
- C. This Deed is supplemental to the Funding Agreement.

1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 Words, expressions and interpretations used in this Deed shall, unless the context expressly requires otherwise, have the meaning given to them in, and shall be interpreted in accordance with, the Funding Agreement.

2. VARIATION OF THE FUNDING AGREEMENT

- 2.1 The Parties agree that with effect from the date of this Deed the Funding Agreement shall be amended as follows.
 - 2.1.1 The words 'Ponteland Community Middle School' on page 1 shall be deleted and replaced by 'Ponteland Community Primary School'.
 - 2.1.2 In the Summary Sheet on page 4, the words 'Ponteland Community Middle School' opposite 'Name of academy' shall be deleted and replaced by 'Ponteland Community Primary School'.
 - 2.1.3 The Capacity number of '584' in the Summary Sheet on page 4 shall be deleted and replaced by '210 plus 30 full-time equivalent pre-school places for nursery and two year old children'.
 - 2.1.4 The Age range of '9 - 13' in the Summary Sheet on page 4 shall be deleted and replaced by an Age range of '2 - 11'.
 - 2.1.5 The definition of "The **Academy**" in clause 1.C on page 8 shall be deleted and replaced by

"The **Academy**" means Ponteland Community Primary School.

2.1.6 Clause 2.B shall be deleted and replaced by the following.

The planned capacity of the Academy is 210 plus 30 full-time equivalent pre-school places for nursery and two year old children, in the age range 2 - 11. The Academy will be an all ability inclusive school.

2.2 Except as varied by this Deed, the Funding Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Governing law and jurisdiction

3.1 This Deed, and any disputes or claims arising out of or in connection with it, its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims), shall be governed by and construed in accordance with English law.

3.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the English courts have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Deed or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

4. Counterparts

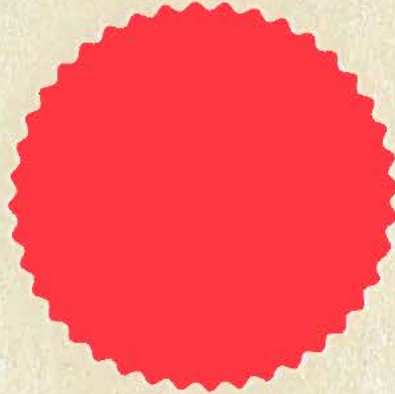
